1. A total of 85 lots will be selected for the sale. Categories will be limited to 15 Bulls, 35 3n1's and pairs, 30 bred/exposed and open heifers and 10 bred cows.
2. There will be a \$50.00 premium fee per lot for the futurity. This money will be used for prize money and trophies; if however you do not bring the lot to the sale, the premium fee for that lot will be applied to sale expenses.
3. Any member of BBU is eligible to nominate cattle for this sale, provided they are a LOBBA member or becomes a member of the LOBBA (\$30.00).
4. This is a BBU Approved Sale and all rules governing same shall apply.

A maximum of four lots per consignor will be accepted and only one bull per consignor if we exceed a total of 15 bulls (herd bulls and herd bull prospects only). Due to the limited number of bulls and heifers in this sale, a consignor who consigns a multiple of bulls or heifers, may be required to reduce the number of bulls or heifers consigned in an effort to keep the total numbers down. If more than 15 bulls and 30 heifers are consigned, the sale manager will determine which cattle will be selected for the sale. In the event that the total numbers consigned exceed 85 lots, LOBBA reserves the right to change the total number of lots a seller may consign or change the number of cattle within categories to achieve a total 85 lots. If a consignor wishes to consign more cattle, LOBBA and the Sale Manager will consider it after the nomination deadline.

**Deadline to Enter: July 15, 2011**

**\*\*\*\*IMPORTANT: Bedding of pens (especially with hay) will not be allowed because of environmental issues. Cleanup and disposal have become almost impossible and very expensive. If you feed hay, we recommend that you use hay bags or feed in tubs. Consignors are responsible for their own pens – you will probably need a shovel or fork. Light bedding with wood shavings will be ok. LOBBA has a committee that will inspect the pens after the sale, and if the pens you used are considered dirty you will be charged for the cleanup of those pens.**

Consignment must consist of the following:

- Completed and signed consignment form
- Premium Fees (Prize money) - \$50.00 per lot **NON-REFUNDABLE**
- This fee must accompany all consignments - No Exceptions**
- Breeding Certificates ( Original)

(Optional) Fee for Ranch Visit to inspect and select cattle for the sale is available at \$100 per ranch visit. This information must be received in my office before inspections will be scheduled. Footnotes are optional and we recommend them.

Health Papers - Any cattle old enough to require Brucellosis Testing must meet those requirements. Texas is now a T.B. Free State. Semen test and scrotal circumference on bulls and palpation on females must be shown on the health certificate. Testing must be done within 30 days of sale date. Health certificates must meet the standards of both state and federal requirements. Bulls 18 months of age and older must pass a Breeding Soundness Evaluation (BSE). **The BSE can be filled out by a licensed Vet on the enclosed form provided by BBU or on the form issued by the Society of Theriogenology.** **Health Information:** A separated health certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian is required on each lot consigned with all required information appearing thereon:

1. Brucellosis tests are required on cattle old enough to be tested, unless you are a Certified Free Herd.
2. Texas does recognize TB Free States. You do not have to TB test, unless you are from an area that requires it.
3. All bulls must meet Trich Requirements, Fertility test, scrotal circumference and BSE test as stipulated above.
4. Palpation on each female.
5. Have your vet check all eligible females to be sure they are Calfhood Vaccinated. If the females you have consigned are Calfhood Vaccinated for Brucellosis, this information must be stated on your health papers. **Testing must be done within 30 days of Sale Date.** Health certificates must meet the standard of both state and federal requirements and must accompany all cattle upon delivery at the sale site.

This futurity is open to bulls, 3n1's, pairs, bred, and open heifers. The following rules apply to each category.

**Herd Bulls & Herd Bull Prospects** (15): **Bulls** - The age requirement is 18 months to a maximum of 36 months. We do reserve the right to accept older bulls, but only well proven bulls with pedigree and reputation. This would be very limited and determined by the sale manager. All bulls must be fertility tested and have scrotal circumference in centimeters within 30 days prior to sale date. A Breeding Soundness Evaluation(BSE) must be done on each bull and may be done within 45 days of sale date. This information may be on a form provided by BBU or the Society of Theriogenology. All bulls must meet requirements for brucellosis, T.B. and must meet Trich requirements.

**3-N-1's and Pairs** (35): Maximum age requirement 96 months (8 years). Any female with a calf at side that is over 6 months of age must be palpated safe in calf.

**Bred Cows** (10): (age limit 72 months) Only the highest quality will be accepted. Must be heavy bred to have a fall calf. Must have production records to prove fertility.

**Bred and Exposed Heifers** (30): Age limit is 15 months to 36 months. Any heifer over 24 months of age must be palpated safe in calf according to BBU's Terms and Conditions.

**Open Heifers**: Age limit up to 24 months of age.

**Note: Picks will be accepted; however, LOBBA is requiring that only cattle that are at least ½ blood related be accepted as picks. They must be out of the same sire or dam.**

Notes on Special Female Lots: Donor cows will not be accepted unless they fit into one of the above listed classes. Any donor selling must abide by the BBU Approved Sale Rules. Picks - Consignor will select one of the pick to be judged.

Brands on all animals must be clipped to permit proper identification by BBU and Sale Management personnel. All cattle will be screened by BBU and Sale Management at the sale site. Any animal not meeting all the above listed requirements or any animal not of outstanding quality and in acceptable sale condition will be sifted and not allowed to sell.

NOTE: Once the cattle are at the sale, and BBU and the sale manager have approved the cattle for sale, consignors may not remove their cattle from the sale.

**OPTIONAL:** Ranch visits are optional at \$50 per head not to exceed \$100 per ranch visit. Ranch visits must be paid by the nomination deadline and is non-refundable once your cattle have been inspected.

**IMPORTANT:** NOMINATION DEADLINE IS **July 15, 2011**. IF WE HAVE NOT RECEIVED 85 LOTS BY THIS DATE, WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO ALLOW CONSIGNORS TO CONSIGN ADDITIONAL CATTLE UNTIL WE HAVE REACHED 85 LOTS.
